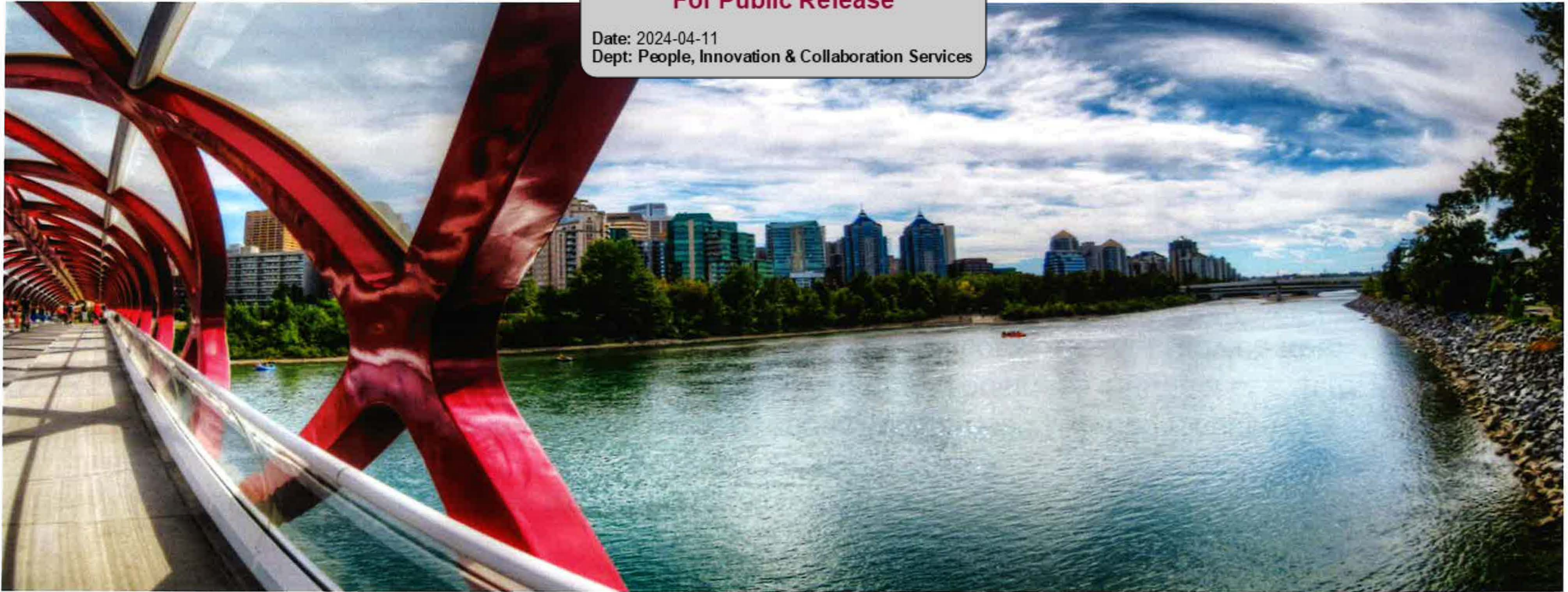

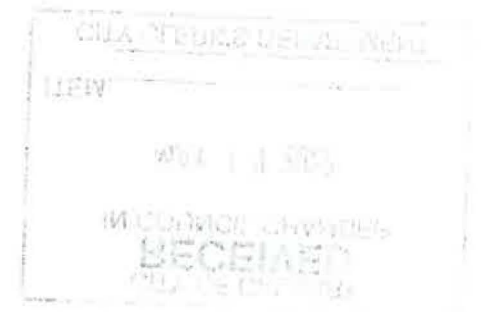

# HIGHLIGHTS

Municipal Affairs has indicated upcoming stakeholder consultations with municipalities late spring early summer on the following:

- Determination of Population Regulation (reinstatement)
- Local Government Fiscal Framework (LGFF)
- Local Authority Election Act (LAEA)
- Off-site levies



# Determination of Population Regulation

- Administration engaged with general questions on determination of population regulation the week of May 7<sup>th</sup>
- Administration (Elections Calgary and ICS) attended a remote stakeholder session hosted by Municipal Affairs on May 17<sup>th</sup>
- Next Steps



# Local Government Fiscal Framework

- Initial meeting hosted by Minister of Municipal Affairs – May 4<sup>th</sup>
- Municipal Affairs circulated draft funding survey for review and comment – May 10
- Municipal Affairs opened survey to municipalities on May 16<sup>th</sup> closing on June 13<sup>th</sup>
- Scope of engagement for Calgary and Edmonton does not include funding formula (focus is on program design)



# Local Authorities Election Act (LAEA)

- Municipal engagement expected spring/summer 2022
- Defined scope
- Timelines could be a challenge
- Report to Council on submission projected for July or September



## Off-site Levies

- Stakeholder engagement on City Charter Off-site Levies authority to be hosted with Calgary, Edmonton and Industry Stakeholders
- Goal and scope of engagement is not clear
