To Mayor Gondek and the Calgary City Council,

As Chief of the Tsuut'ina Nation, I would like to express my support for the Alberta 2030 Commonwealth Games bid. We have been working with the Bid Organization for the last two years, and as a true partner in this effort, we know that co-hosting the Games will bring significant and generational opportunities to the Nation.

These Games will position the Nation on the world stage, and act as a catalyst for tourism, investment, and opportunities of all kinds.

A successful bid will see the construction of new sporting and cultural infrastructure on the reserve, including a shooting range that we fully expect the City of Calgary Police Service will utilize for training and certification. As a hosting partner, we are looking to host three Commonwealth Games sporting events on reserve land, which I understand is a first for a major sporting event of this kind, and which will provide an unparalleled opportunity for Tsuut'ina Nation youth. Never before have our young people been given the chance to train and compete at this level without leaving the reserve. With this home-field advantage, we know that Tsuut'ina competitors will emerge and excel, and our programs will continue to develop for years after the Games are over.

I see this event as an important step on the road to reconciliation. It will not only fulfill the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Call to Action number 91, it will also help in kindling important relationships between the Nation, the City, the Province, the Federal Government, and indigenous partners in the Treaty 6 & 7 territories like the Enoch Cree Nation.

I am excited to welcome the Games to Tsuut'ina, and I look forward to continuing to collaborate with Calgary in working towards a successful bid.
