The City of Calgary’s (“The City”) Environmental and Safety Management (“ESM”) Business Unit’s is responsible for organizing an annual Calgary Climate Symposium, which falls in line with the goals of The City’s Climate Resilience Strategy (approved by City Council on June 25, 2018). The Climate Resilience Strategy outlines The City’s strategies and actions to 1) reduce our contributions to climate change by improving energy management and reducing greenhouse gas emissions (climate change mitigation); and 2) Respond to a changing climate by implementing risk management measures to reduce the impact of extreme weather events and climatic changes on infrastructure and services (climate change adaptation).
