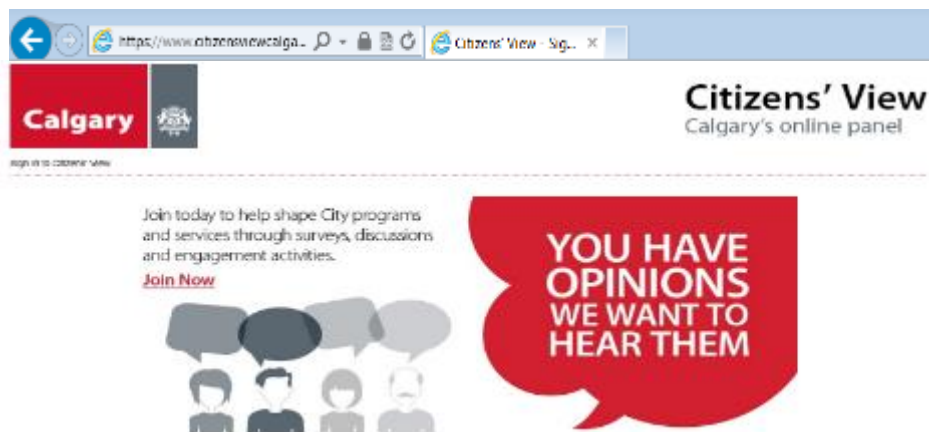
## Methodology

Ipsos conducted an online survey with Citizens' View panelists.

Citizens' View is an online panel that encourages citizens to participate in shaping City of Calgary programs and services through surveys, discussions and engagement activities.

The survey was launched on May 17 to 3,444 panelists. A total of 926 came to the survey site, among whom 56 (2% of the total outgo) dropped out and 870 (25% of the outgo) panelists completed the survey by May 23. Panelists who do not drive were excluded from the survey.

**The following findings may not be statistically representative of all Calgarians. The work is exploratory as a result of the make up of panelists currently on the Citizens' View panel. The results should be regarded as directional and should not be projected to the larger population without research with a representative sample of citizens.**





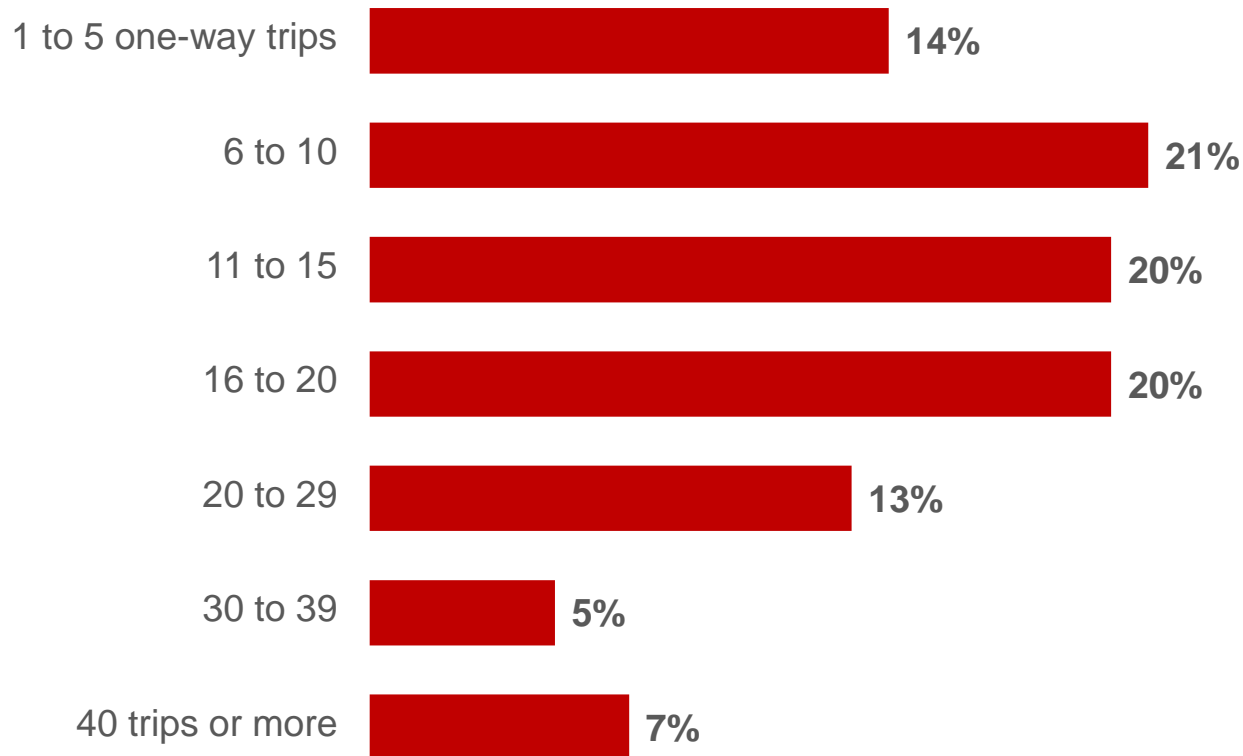


## Summary of Findings

# Overview of Findings

- The majority of panelists who drive access traffic information, with one-third accessing it at least half of the time that they make a trip when they are driving. Around three-in-ten access traffic information never or almost never.
- Nearly one-half of panelists access traffic information using radio, TV or newspapers at least several times per week, while one-quarter use an app on a smart phone and 13% a GPS with traffic information that often. Virtual assistance and websites accessed on a computer are used by smaller segments of panelists who drive.
- Two-thirds of panelists who use websites use Google maps, while around one-third use each of AMA road reports and news websites. Only 16% mention using the Calgary.ca Traffic Report.
- When it comes to apps, Google maps is the dominant source for travel information, mentioned by 83% of app users.
- When panelists who drive use real time traffic information, they are most likely to be looking for the best route to take under current traffic conditions. Accidents, construction and traffic flow are also frequently mentioned.
- Usage of the Traffic Report on The City of Calgary Website is quite low, with only 6% of respondents who make at least one driving trip per week stating that they have ever used it.
- When non-users of the Traffic Report are provided with a description of the site and asked how likely they would be to use it in future, only 11% state that they would be very likely to do so. The reasons for lack of interest predominantly revolve around preferences for other sources, including both online sources and traditional media.

## Average Number of One-Way Trips Per Week Made Driving a Car or Other Vehicle



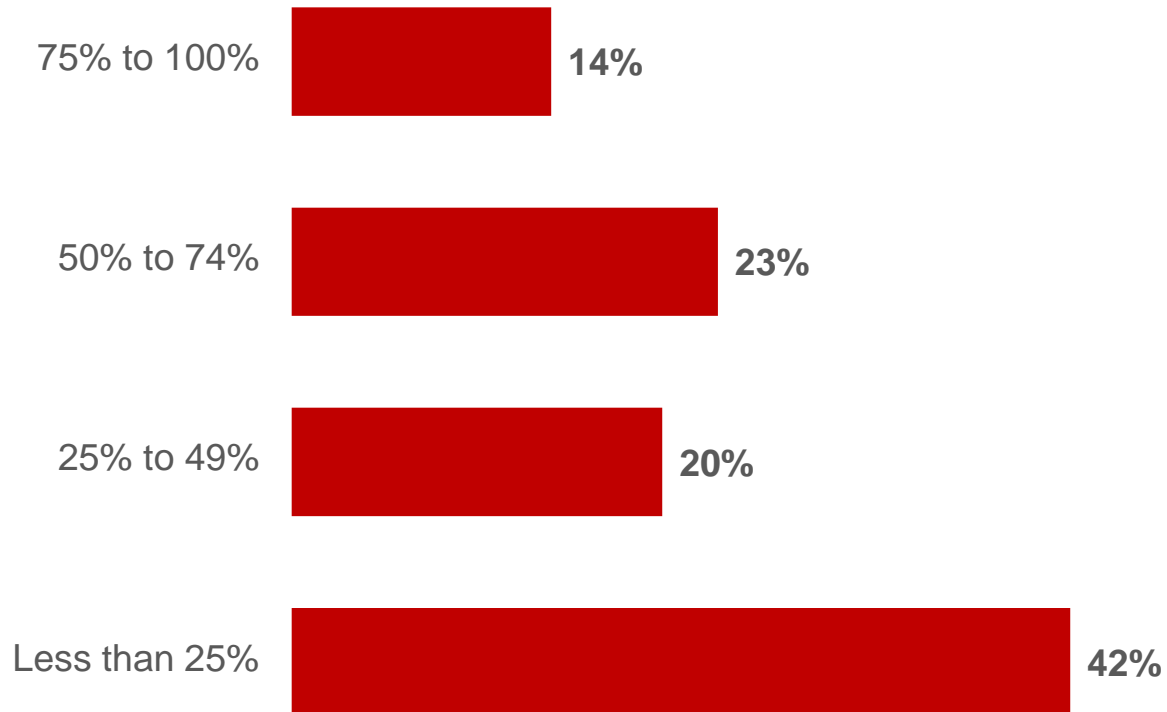

## Proportion of Trips Made During Rush Hour

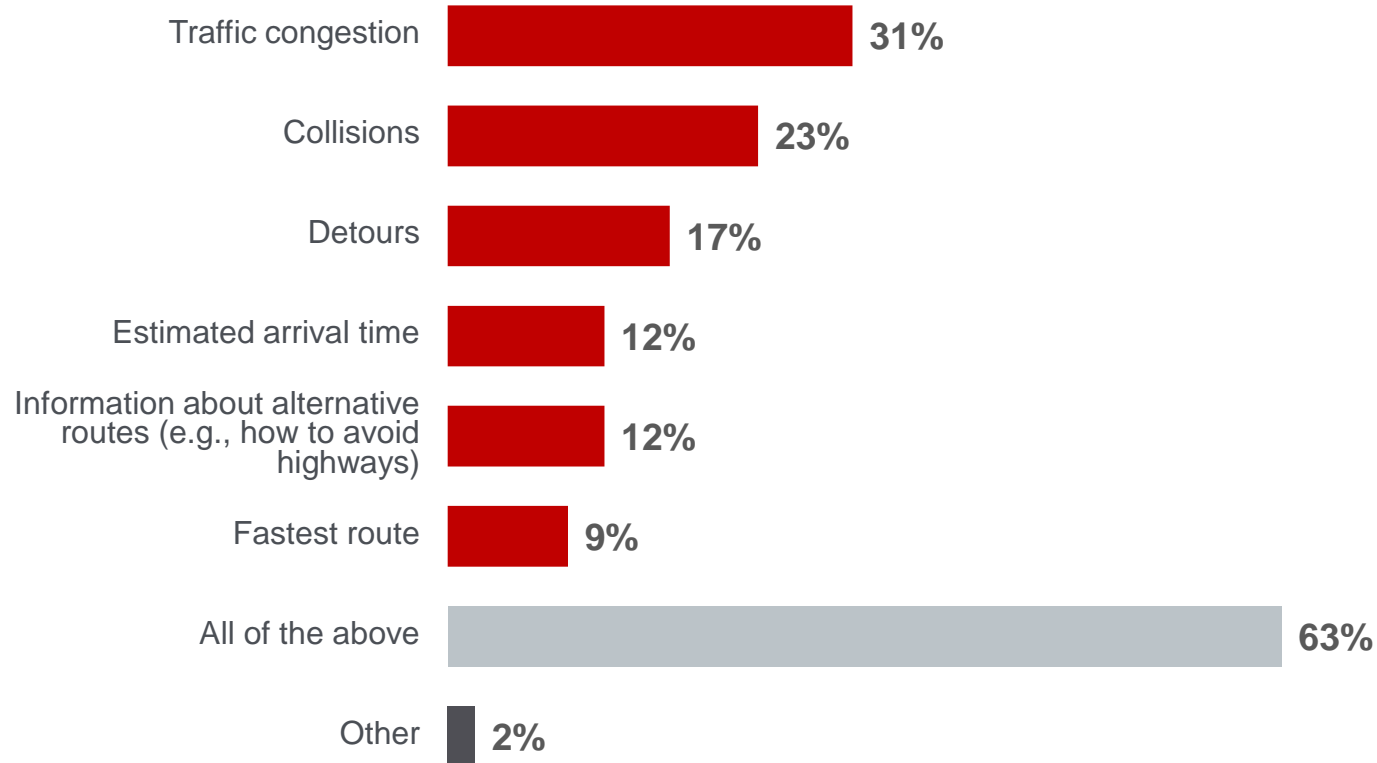

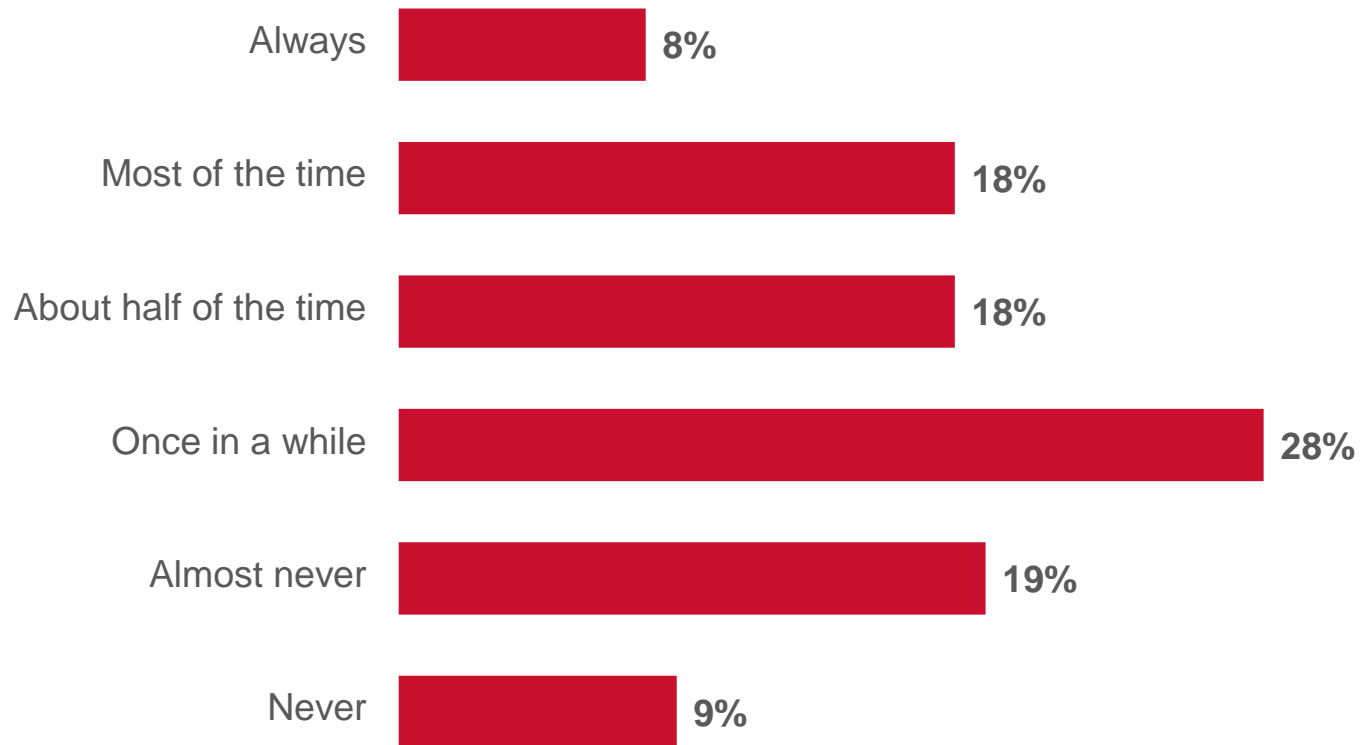
## What Comes to Mind Thinking of ‘Real Time Traffic Information’

# How Often Access Traffic Information

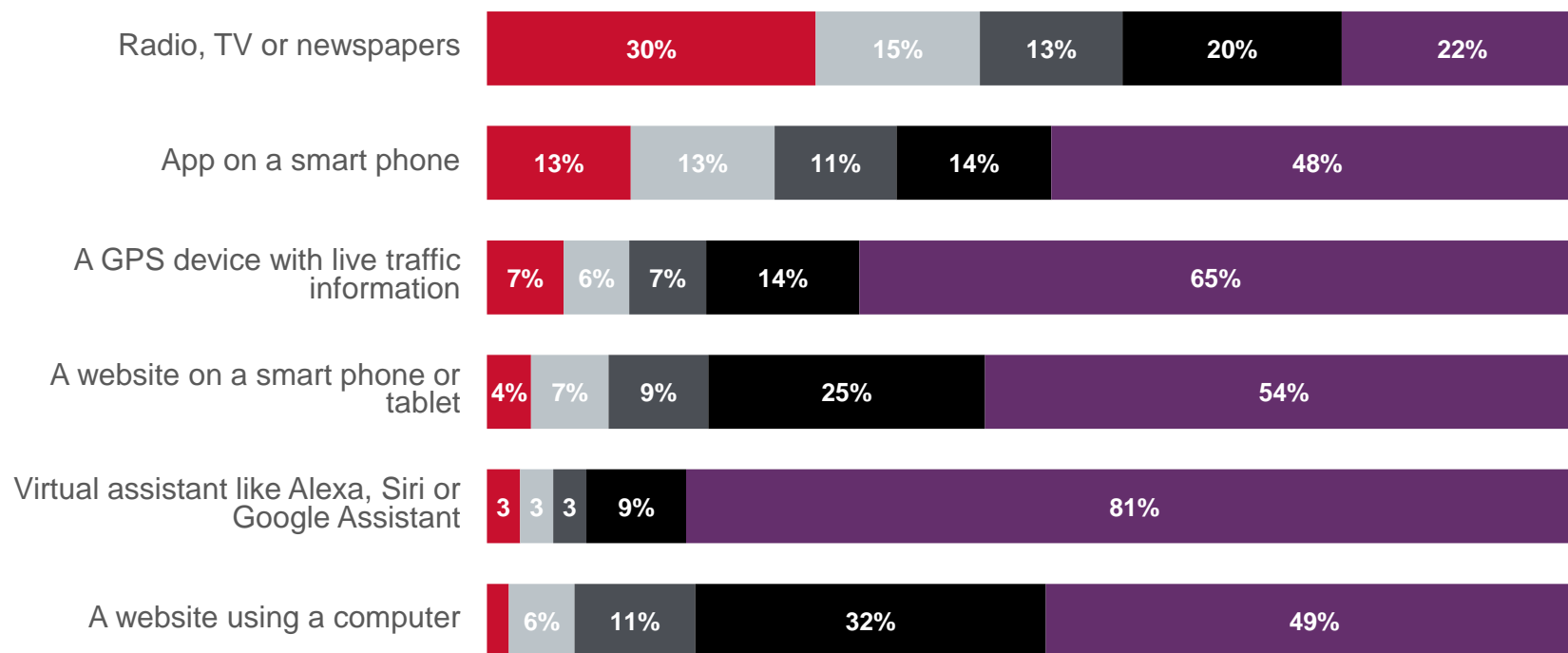


Q4. During or before a trip when you are driving, how often do you access traffic information?

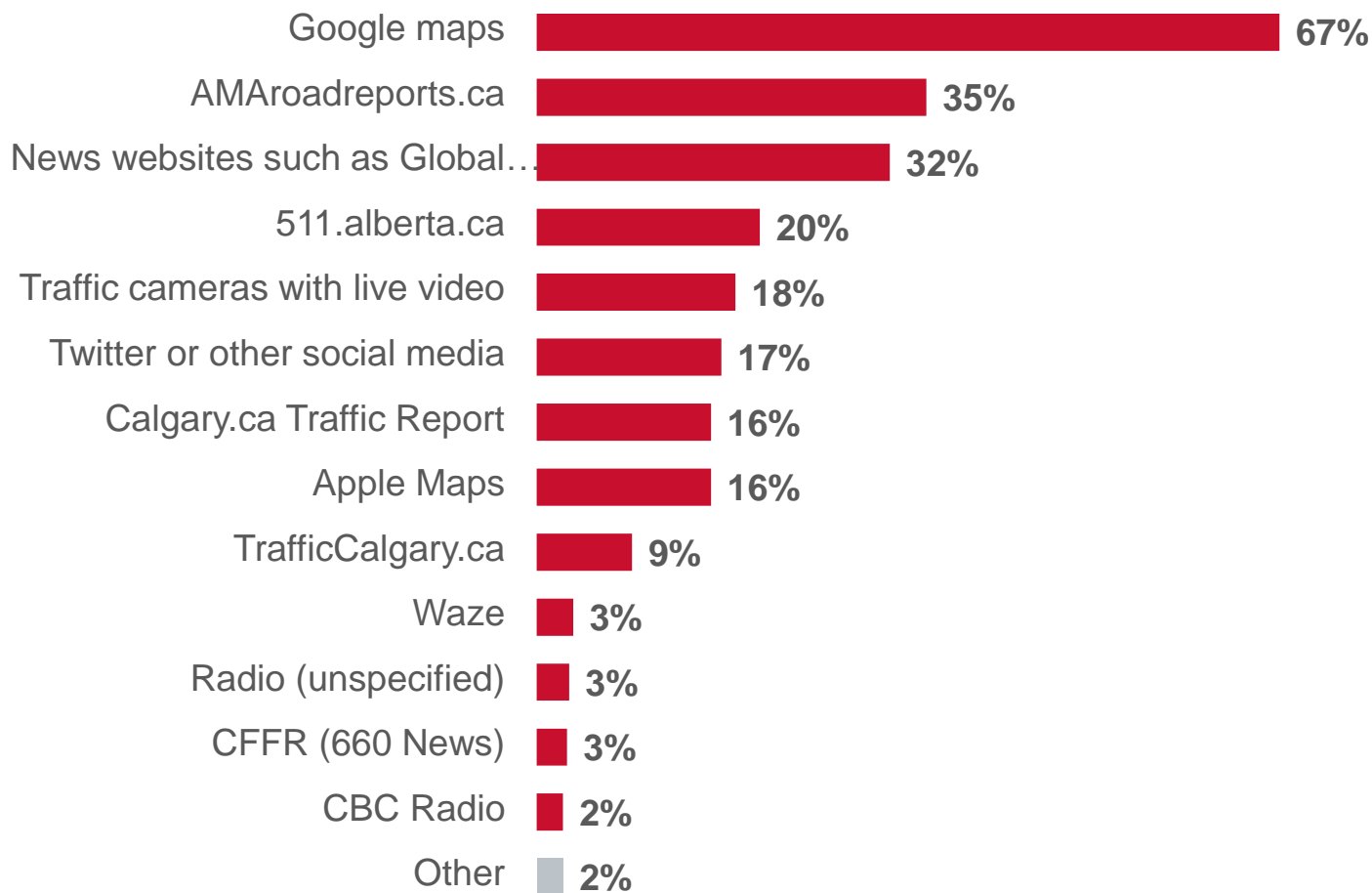

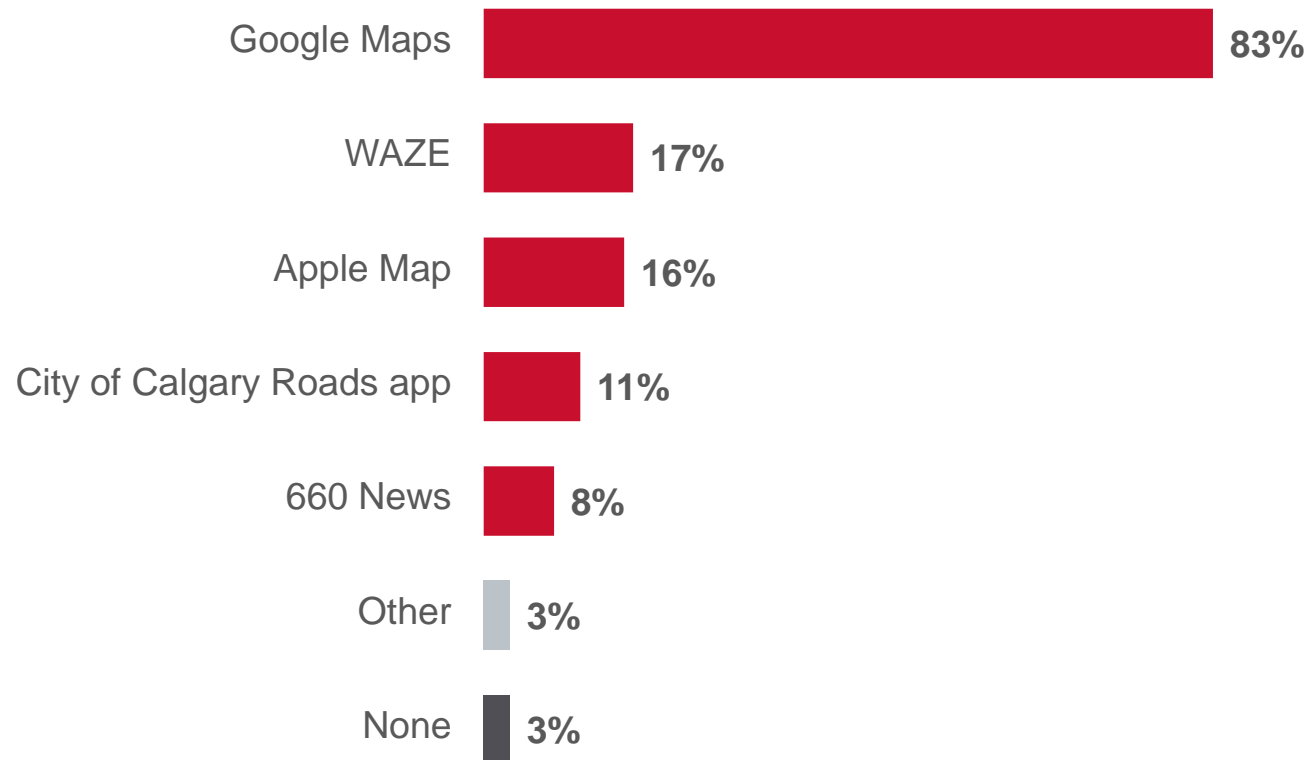
## Websites or Tools Used for Traffic Information

# Apps Used for Traffic Information

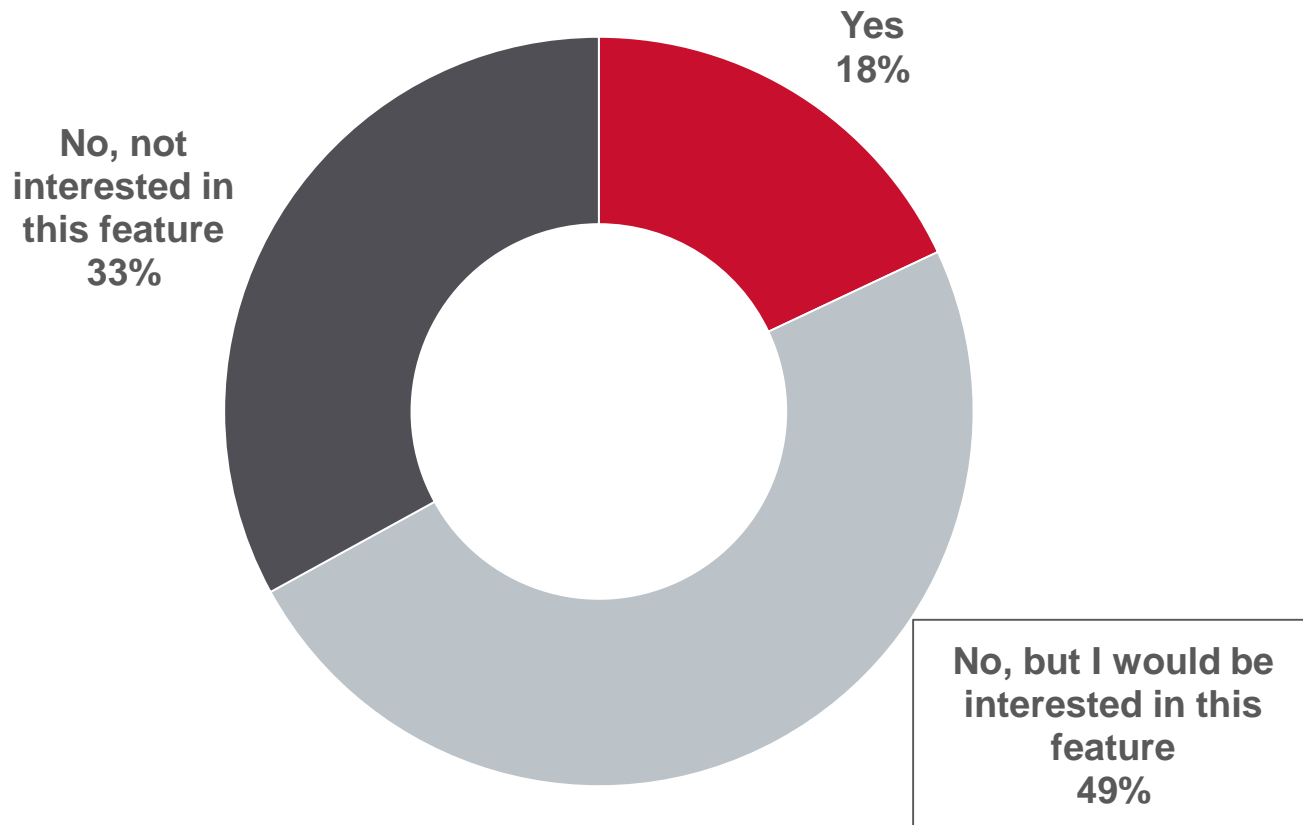


Q7. Which apps do you use for traffic information? Please select all that apply.

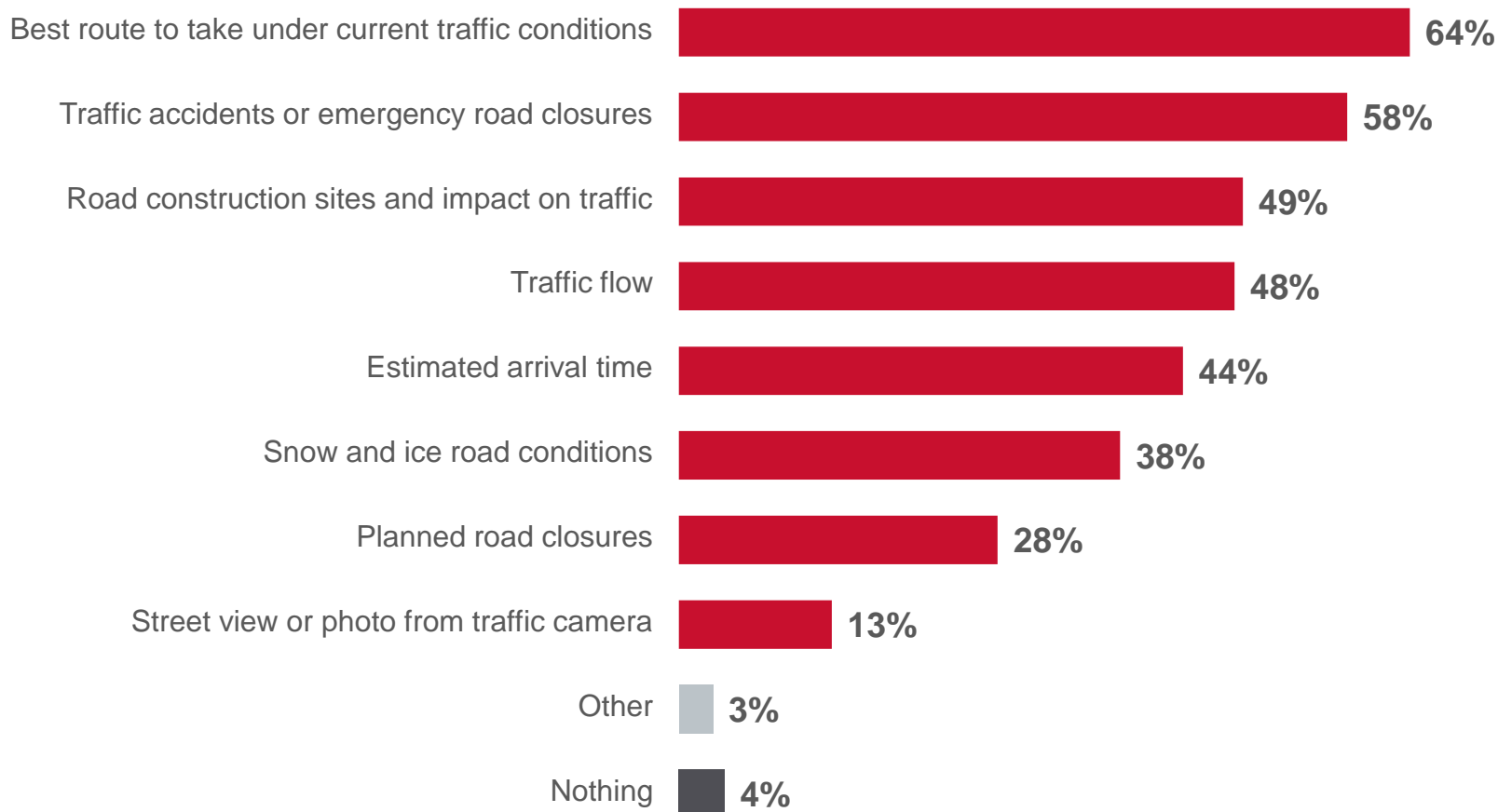
## Whether Get Alerts or Push Notifications with Traffic Information

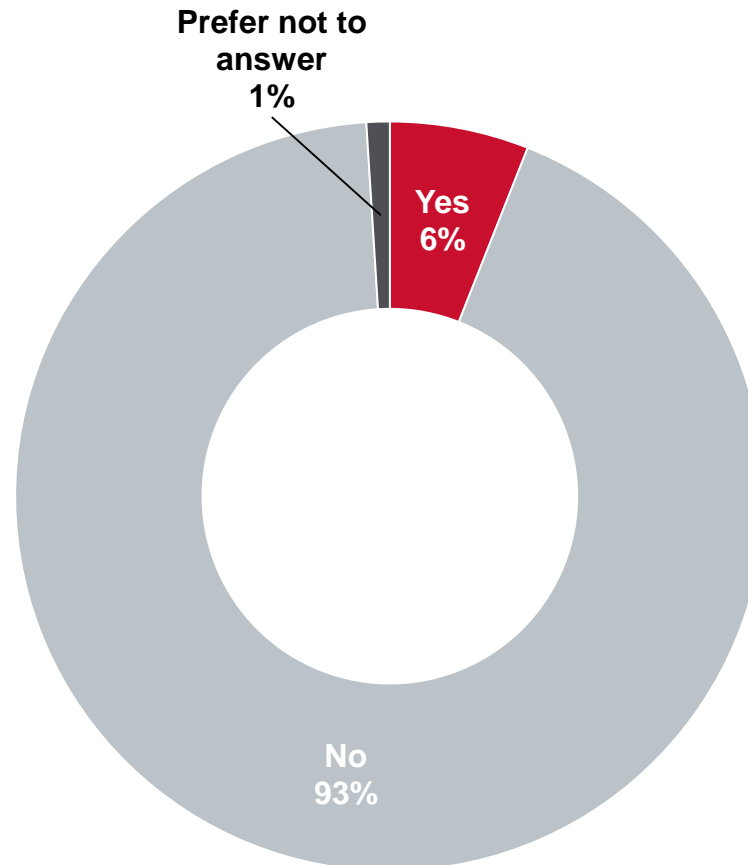
# Type of Traffic Information Usually Looking For

# Whether Ever Use the Traffic Report on The City of Calgary Website

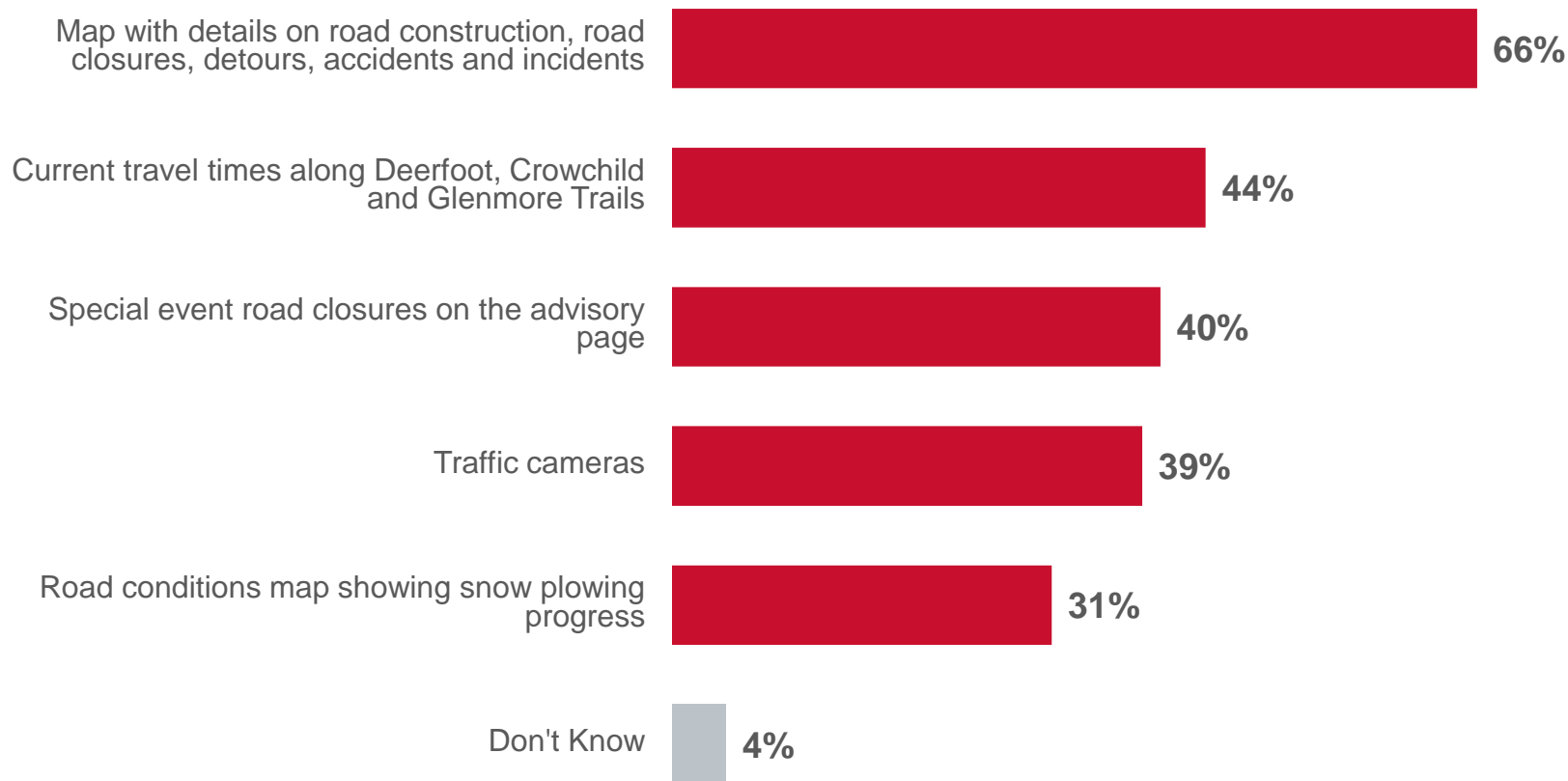

Suggestions for improvements include:

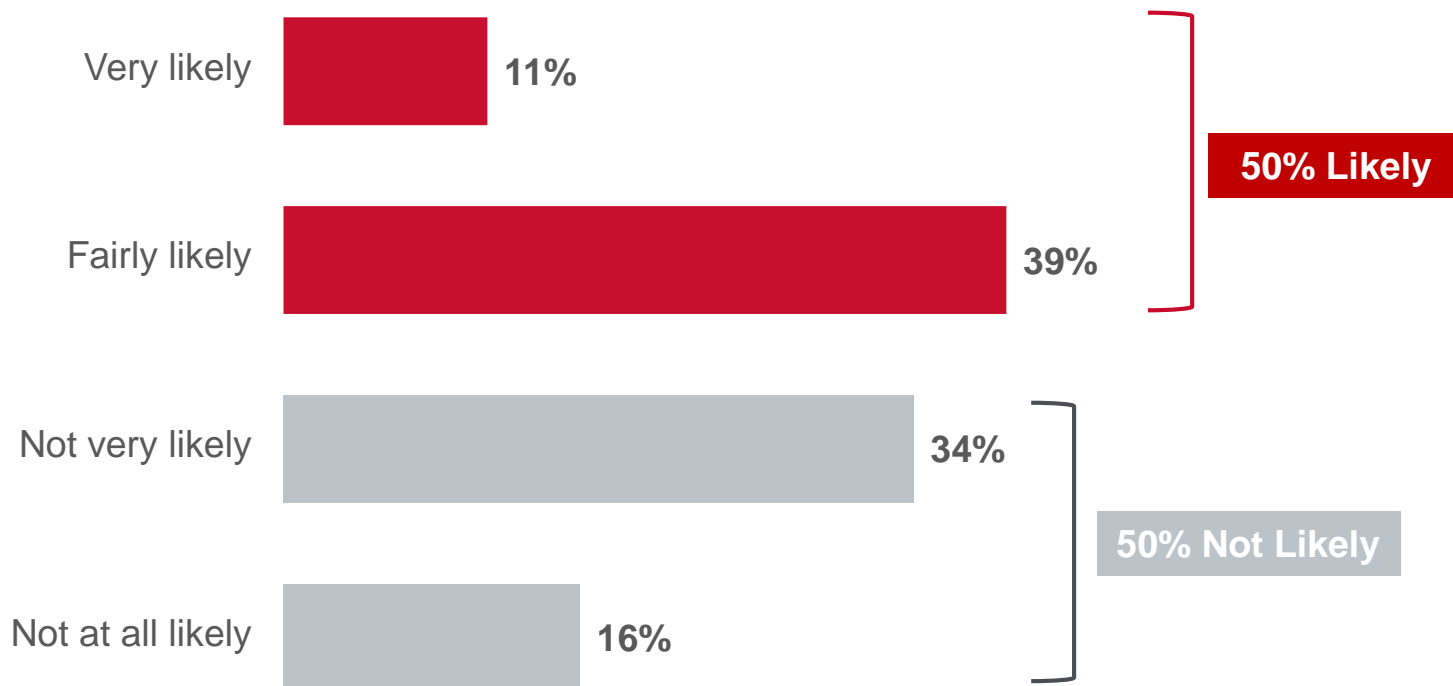
- *“Road conditions (road construction, road closures, detours, accidents, incidents)”*

## Likelihood of Using the Traffic Information Report on the City of Calgary's Website Among Non-Users

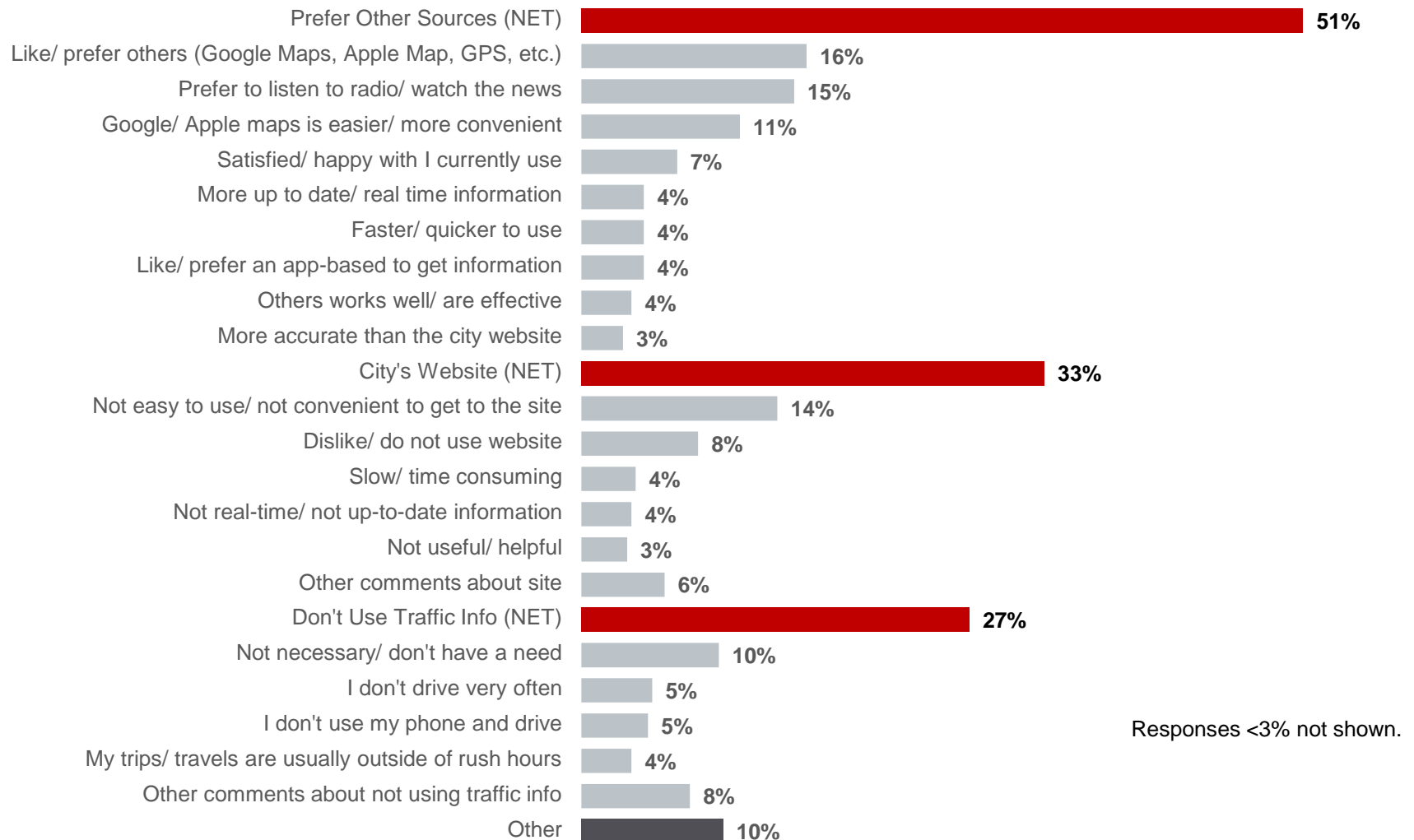

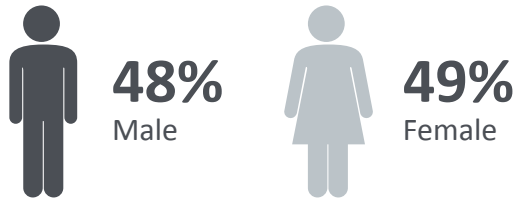

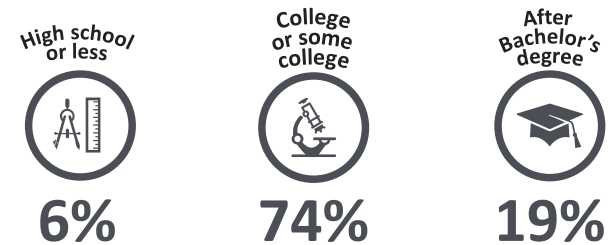

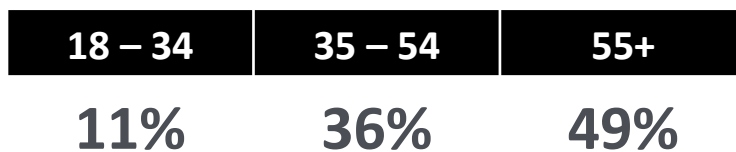

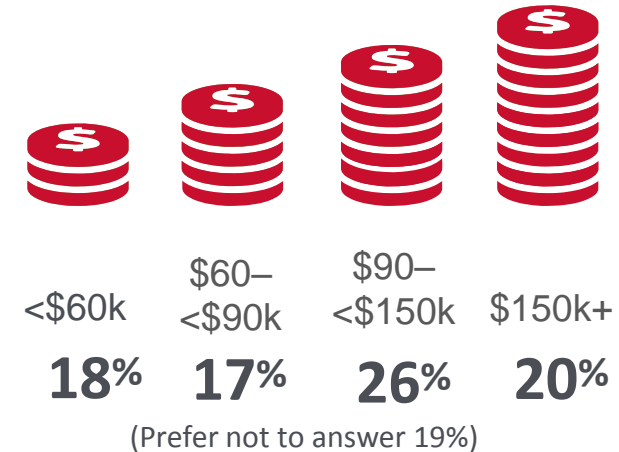

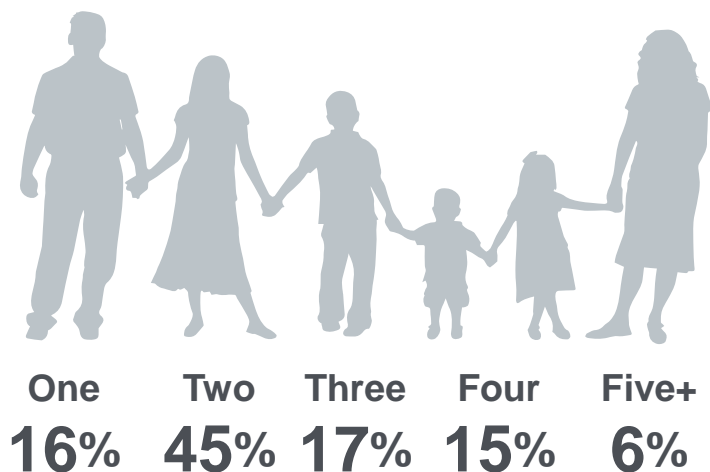

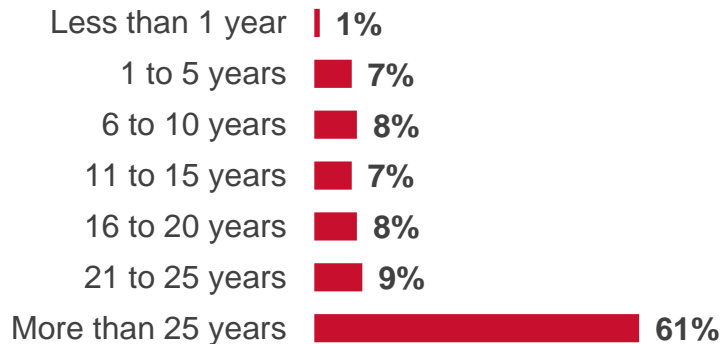
