


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- ◆ Telephone survey conducted with a randomly selected sample of 2,452 Calgarians aged 18 years and older between August 20th and September 10th, 2015.
 - ❖ Both landline (70%) and cell phone (30%) sample were used.
 - ❖ The average interview length was 30 minutes.
- ◆ Final data were weighted to ensure the overall sample's quadrant, ward and age/gender composition reflects that of the actual Calgary population aged 18 or older according to 2011 Federal Census data.
- ◆ The margin of error (MOE) for the total sample of 2,452 is ± 2.0 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.
 - ❖ A total of 172 interviews were conducted with residents of Ward 7 (MOE ± 7.5).
- ◆ Research note on significant differences.
 - ❖ Throughout, City Wide results are compared to results from Ward 7.
 - \uparrow indicates number is significantly higher than City Wide.
 - \downarrow indicates number is significantly lower than City Wide.
 - ❖ Where possible, 2015 results for Ward 7 are compared to those from 2014.
 - Only significant differences are shown.

Summary of Key Findings

Ward 7 residents continue to express positive views of the quality of life in Calgary. While perceptions of overall quality of life are on par with City wide results, Ward 7 residents differ from the broader Calgary public on several sustainability metrics.

- ◆ In line with City wide results (86%), 85% of Ward 7 residents say the quality of life in Calgary is good.
- ◆ However, Ward 7 residents are significantly less likely to agree with the statements 'I am proud to be a Calgarian' (85% vs. 90% City wide) and 'The City of Calgary municipal government fosters a city that is inclusive and accepting of all' (72% vs. 80%).
- ◆ Conversely, Ward 7 residents are significantly more likely to say they *completely* agree with the statement 'I am proud to live in my neighbourhood' (41% vs. 31%).
- ◆ Compared to 2014, there has been a 14 percentage point decrease in Ward 7 residents' agreement with the statement 'Calgary is a great place to make a living' (76% in 2015 vs. 90% in 2014).



Summary of Key Findings

Consistent with City Wide results, “*infrastructure, traffic and roads*” is in the top position on the 2015 Ward 7 issue agenda, though gains are seen, particularly in the area of snow removal.

- ◆ Four-in-ten (39%) Ward 7 residents say “*infrastructure, traffic and roads*” is an important issue. This is on par with City wide results (36%).
 - ❖ Within this broader category, mentions of “*infrastructure maintenance/improvement/development*” are significantly higher than City wide (14% vs. 9%).
 - ❖ However, compared to one year ago, significantly fewer Ward 7 residents this year mention “*road conditions/roads*” (6% vs. 12% 2014) and “*lack of snow removal*” (1% vs. 8% 2014).
- ◆ It is also notable that significantly fewer Ward 7 residents cite improvements to “*transportation*” as an action The City could take to improve the quality of life (25% in 2015 vs. 36% in 2014).
- ◆ Further, *very satisfied* ratings are significantly higher than both current City wide and 2014 Ward 7 results for:
 - ❖ Snow removal – 40% versus 27% City wide, and up from 28% in 2014; and,
 - ❖ Road maintenance – 30% versus 23% City wide, and up from 20% in 2014.
- ◆ Also of note, invest *more* ratings for snow removal are significantly lower among Ward 7 residents (39% vs. 54% City wide), and down from 2014 (53%).
- ◆ Finally, City operated roads and infrastructure emerges as a ‘primary strength’ in the Ward 7 importance versus satisfaction analysis (whereas it is a ‘primary weakness’ City wide).



Summary of Key Findings

As with City wide “transit” continues to hold second place on the Ward 7 issue agenda – there are, however, some notable differences from City wide findings.

- ◆ While 12% of City wide residents mention “education”, only 5% of Ward 7 residents raise this as an important issue.
 - ❖ “Education” mentions among Ward 7 residents have dropped significantly this year as compared to 2014 (5% vs. 14%).
- ◆ However, Ward 7 residents are more likely than the broader Calgary public to mention both “growth and planning” (11% vs. 4%) and “budget and spending” (7% vs. 4%).

Downtown revitalization is a more prominent issue for Ward 7 residents compared to the broader Calgary public.

- ◆ Four-in-ten (40%) Ward 7 residents say downtown revitalization is *very* important, significantly higher than 32% City wide.
- ◆ Further, invest *more* ratings are significantly higher (32% vs. 25% City wide).
- ◆ And, one-third (33%) are *very* satisfied, higher than City wide (25%), and up 15 percentage points from 2014 (18%).



Summary of Key Findings

Among Ward 7 residents, a number of notable differences and changes are seen with regard to recreation and community services.

- ◆ More than two-in-ten (22%) Ward 7 residents cite improvements to *"recreation and community services"* as an action The City could take to improve the quality of life. While this is on par with City wide (17%), it represents an 11 percentage point increase from 2014 (11%).
 - ❖ Mentions of *"building of community centres/recreation facilities"* is also up (9% vs. 1% in 2014).
 - ❖ It is interesting then that invest *more* ratings for City operated recreation facilities is significantly lower among Ward 7 residents (29%) than City wide (38%).
- ◆ The importance of social services for individuals such as seniors and youth is also up from one year ago (99% vs. 89% important, and 80% vs. 67% *very* important).
- ◆ Components of recreation where Ward 7 residents differ from the broader Calgary public are:
 - ❖ Calgary's pathway system – *Very* important ratings are significantly higher than City wide (69% vs. 58%), as are satisfaction ratings (60% vs. 50% *very* satisfied).
 - ❖ Bike lanes on streets – More than six-in-ten (61%) Ward 7 residents rate this as important (vs. 53% City wide), with 36% saying bike lanes are *very* important (vs. 25% City wide).
 - ❖ Calgary's parks, playgrounds and other open spaces – Close to two thirds (64%) of Ward 7 residents are *very* satisfied compared to 54% City wide.



Summary of Key Findings

Ward 7 residents are comparatively less satisfied with The City's environmental performance.

- ◆ More than eight-in-ten (85%) Ward 7 residents say they are satisfied with the job The City is doing to protect the environment – while still very high, this is significantly lower than City wide (91%).
- ◆ Also, although the vast majority (95%) of Ward 7 residents rate the overall state of Calgary's environment as good, this is down significantly from 99% in 2014.

Ward 7 residents' appetite for tax increases has dropped significantly this year.

- ◆ When asked to choose between increasing taxes to expand or maintain service levels, or cut services to maintain or reduce taxes, just 54% of Ward 7 residents opt for tax increases – down 16 percentage points from 2014 (70%).
 - ❖ Conversely, 41% of Ward 7 residents would opt for cutting services, significantly higher than 2014 (24%).
- ◆ Ward 7 residents are significantly less likely than the broader Calgary public to agree with the statement 'I am interested in knowing how my property tax dollars are invested in various City services' (85% vs. 93%).
 - ❖ At the same time, a greater proportion of Ward 7 residents say they *strongly* agree with the statement 'The City does a good job of providing citizens with information about how their property tax dollars are invested in various City services' (19% vs. 13%).



Summary of Key Findings

Fewer Ward 7 residents report contacting The City this year as compared to 2014.

- ◆ Two-thirds (67%) of Ward 7 residents say they have contacted or dealt with The City in the last 12 months, down 11 percentage points from 2014 (78%).

There are no other noteworthy differences between Ward 7 residents and the broader Calgary public with regard to City Communications.



Overall Quality of Life in Calgary




On a scale of "1" to "10" where "1" represents "very poor" and "10" represents "very good" how would you rate the overall quality of life in the city of Calgary today?












Thinking about all of the services and programs provided by The City of Calgary, what services come to mind?
























Importance vs. Satisfaction Grid: City Wide



Perceptions About Overall State of Calgary's Environment




Thinking about things such as air, water and land quality in the city, how would you rate the overall state of Calgary's environment today?

Satisfaction with The City's Environmental Performance




How satisfied are you with the job The City of Calgary is currently doing to protect the environment?



Knowledge Levels of Tax Dollar Spending



Perceived Value of Property Taxes



Balancing Taxation and Service Delivery Levels









Past 12 Months Contact with The City of Calgary





Satisfaction with the Overall Level and Quality of Customer Service





How satisfied were you with your most recent contact with The City?





The Extent of Information Received




In your opinion, do you currently receive too much, too little, or just the right amount of information from The City?
